When heart stops by some kind of reasons, an arrhythmic state called the ventricular fibrillation occurs that heart shakes with finely. It is necessary to perform electronic shocks to return heart to an original state. When electronic shocks are one minute late after falling down, the lifesaving rate is approximately 10% fall down. Because a citizen uses AED, the lifesaving rate increases twofold (to cope earlier). When we meet a person whose heart stops, we demand the help of other people, order AED and constantly compress the chest. A citizen came to be able to use AED in the lifesaving spot from July, 2004. We can use AED by following the voice guide, but we are recommended to attend the lecture of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (from Japanese Association for Acute Medicine).













How to Use an AED

Speak to a victim and see if he or she is conscious or unconscious.
